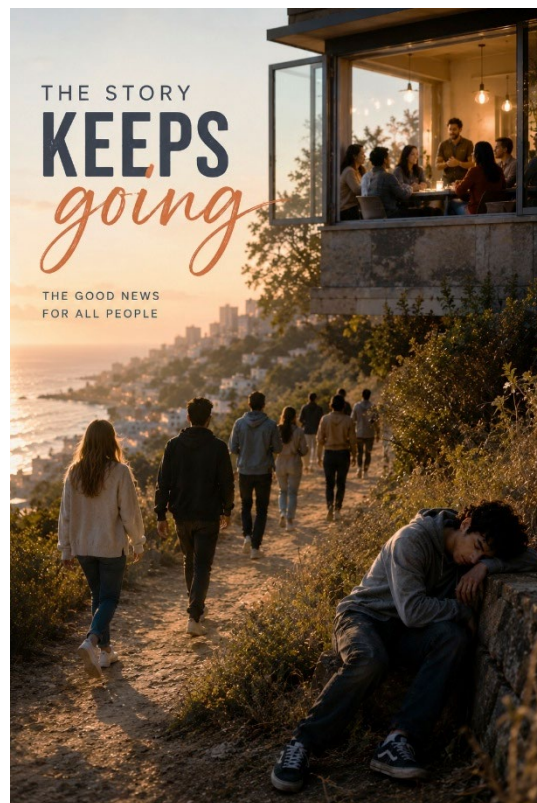





This text was the winner in a hymn competition sponsored by the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) Bicentennial Committee for the 1988–1989 observance, which had the theme “Celebrate the Journey.” The late 18th-century tune (first used with Psalm 148) is appropriately celebratory.

LITANY OF AFFIRMATION

One: There are moments when we run out of energy. We try to listen. We try to pay attention. Then life hits us, and it's as if we fell out of a window. Our attention shatters. Without rest, it is impossible to keep listening for God's voice. Our prayer of confession invites us to admit that we often prefer productivity over rest. And we often prefer other people's productivity over their rest as well. So let us confess the ways that we try to do too much and pray for God's rest to help us reset. Let us pray.

All: Almighty God, you call us to rest. You provide us with times of sabbath so that we can reset our hearts and hear you better in the world around us. You see beyond our productivity. You have given us worth beyond our need to constantly "do." Forgive us for the moments when we talk too much. Forgive us for the moments when we try to focus so hard that we end up falling out of the proverbial windows. Forgive us for not making space for others to rest as well. Call us back to you and give us your perfect peace.

One: Lord, in your mercy,

All: hear our prayers.

(A moment is given for silent confession to God.)
